Learning Area Coordinator – English Year 7-12

This is an ongoing teaching position with an initial 2 year contract as Learning Area Coordinator, with the possibility of an extension to be a Learning Area Coordinator beyond 2019.

St Mary's College is seeking a highly motivated and dynamic English, Years 7-12 Learning Area Coordinator. St Mary's College is a K-12 Catholic College with a total enrolment of 680 students. The Secondary Campus has an enrolment of approximately 230 students from Years 7-12.

The College has a rich history dating back to 1908 when the St John of God Sisters established the first school in Broome for students of Asian families working in the pearling industry. Broome has a population of approximately 15,000 people and is located in the Kimberley region of Western Australia. Broome is a town rich in history and culture. The town is well-established with extensive facilities to cater for both local people and tourists.

The school enjoys a close relationship with the Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish in Broome and has strong support of the parent community.

- Skills and experience in developing, implementing and evaluating curriculum.
- Highly developed skills in the application of technology as a learning, teaching and management tool.
- An ability to foster positive personal relationships with students, with a commitment to their personal growth.
- An ability to work cooperatively and collaboratively as part of a dedicated and committed team of educators.

ESSENTIAL:

- Experience in the teaching of English to Year 12 ATAR levels. Ability to teach EALD would be desirable.
