Introduction

St Mary's College is a Catholic School situated in Broome that provides education from Kindergarten to Year 12, for parents who desire a Catholic education for their children. The College offers students skills to take their place confidently in society while living according to Christian values. The St Mary's College Board seeks to promote opportunities for new Catholic students to enrol by providing scholarships for students in Years 5 to Year 12.

Eligibility Criteria

- Student applicants must be Catholic and not presently enrolled at St Mary's College.
- The student is to have a strong desire for a Catholic education.
- The applicant should be willing to become involved in the College's co-curricular activities in accordance with the ethos of St Mary's College.

Scholarship details and value

The scholarship will cover the full cost of the tuition and subject fees. The scholarship will also cover books and book hire fees.

The scholarship does not cover uniforms or camps.

Conditions

For the recipient, the following factors will be considered in reviewing the continuation of the scholarship:

- Attendance.
- Compliance with the College Enrolment Agreement.
- The scholarship will be ongoing subject to an annual review of the student's attitude and progress.

- A completed scholarship application form.
