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Purpose of Position

Working under the general direction of the Principal through the Business Manager and Grounds and Maintenance Supervisor, the gardener is responsible for the maintenance of College grounds and facilities. This position is a vital role in supporting the education program of the College. The gardener must have a positive attitude and be physically fit to undertake daily duties. The gardener must be aware of and comply with Work Health & Safety policies and practices of the School. The gardener may be required to assist with major school events such as sport carnivals, Masses and other activities, and shall attend staff meetings and other meetings as required conducted at the school or elsewhere, within or outside of the employee's normal working hours.

Core Duties and Responsibilities

Catholic Identity:

- Assist in preparation and marking of grounds for sporting functions

Stewardship:

- Loading, unloading and moving garden supplies and equipment
- preparing garden sites and plots using hand tools and machines
- assisting with planting, transplanting and positioning flowers, shrubs, trees and lawns in gardens
- maintaining gardens by watering, weeding, pruning, mulching and fertilising, operating and adjusting irrigation systems and using protection stratergies
- raking, aerating, dethatching, fertilising and mowing lawns
- spraying and dusting trees, shrubs, lawns and gardens, as directed, to control pests, weeds and disease
- cleaning gardens and removing rubbish
