St Mary's College recognises and respects the uniqueness and individuality of students and families. In partnership, we inspire all to learn, be creative and to have a listening heart.

Scholarship recipients must meet the following criteria:

- · Students applying for a Catholic Scholarship must be baptised Catholic.
- · The student applicant must have a strong desire for a Catholic Education.
- · A willingness to actively contribute to College life through its academic, pastoral, spiritual, sporting and creative art programs.
- The applicant should be willing to become involved in the College's co-curricular activities in accordance with the ethos of St Mary's College.
- · Students applying for an Catholic Scholarship must submit a referral from their Parish Priest.
- · Maintain positive academic performance and record whilst holding the scholarship.
- · The Principal will consider the student's involvement in his/her current school, local parish and local community.
 - 1. The student will be part of our Ministry action group, overseen by our Faith Pillar Leader
 - 2. The student will commit to participate in and undertake specific responsibilities in relation to Catholic events at the College
 - 3. In circumstances where student behaviour becomes unsatisfactory, the Catholic Bursary may be withdrawn. In such circumstances, parents/guardians will be given clear warnings. Each student's academic progress and overall participation will be reviewed by the relevant Deputy Principal on behalf of the Principal, on a regular basis, with any concerns being relayed to the student's parents/ quardians.

Scholarship value:

- · Scholarships offer to cover the full cost of the tuition and subject fees and associated levies.
- The scholarship will also cover the cost of a stationery pack at the beginning of each academic year and book hire fees.

Conditions:

For the recipients, the following factors will be considered in reviewing the continuation of the scholarship.

- · Attendance.
- · Compliance with the St Mary's College Enrolment Agreement.
- · The Scholarship awardees must always strive to uphold the Christian values expected for a St Mary's College student.
- · The Scholarship will be ongoing subject to an annual review of the student's attitude and progress.

The applicant will form part of the College Faith Life Ministry and be expected to contribute to the Faith life of our Collehe and provide student voice.

- Compliance with the St Mary's College Enrolment Agreement.
- The Scholarship awardees must always strive to uphold the Christian values expected for a St Mary's College student.
- · The Scholarship will be ongoing subject to an annual review of the student's attitude and progress.

Selection process:

- The selection process will consist of completion of the application form, Baptism certificate, other available Sacramental certificates and school reports.
- Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend an interview with the Principal and Parish Priest to assist in final selection.
